

CLUB CONSTITUTION WITH REGARD TO RACE NUMBER SWAPPING

The club recognises that members often have to enter races long before the event and inevitably may not be able to take part on the day.

Where the transfer of entries between UKA affiliated runners is permitted by the event organisers, **and** providing that the name and affiliation number has been changed on the list of entrants held by the race organisers, the club will recognise the results of the replacement runner.

In all other cases, including but not limited to situations where:

- numbers have been swapped without informing the event organisers, or
- where event organisers do not permit swaps, or
- where a number swap has been requested but not confirmed in writing by the organisers

any club member found to have run under another runner's name, or to have permitted another runner to run under the name registered with the organisers, will have contravened both the Rules of the UKA and the guidelines of the constitution and therefore may be subject to disciplinary action as deemed appropriate by the committee.
