

CHANGES TO CLUB CONSTITUTION WITH REGARD TO RACE NUMBER SWAPPING

The club recognises that members often have to enter races long before the event and inevitably may not be able to take part on the day.

Where the transfer of entries between UKA affiliated runners is permitted by the event organisers, **and** provided that the name and affiliation number has been changed on the list of entrants held by the race organisers, the club will recognise the results of the replacement runner.

In all other cases, including but not limited to situations where numbers have been swapped without informing the event organisers, or where event organisers do not permit swaps, **any club member found to have run under another runner's name, or to have permitted another runner to run under the original entrant's name, will**

- be suspended from club membership for a period to be determined by the committee
- lose all their race series points earned up to and including the date of the event
- be reported to Glos AAA for breach of UKA rules.
